M. Dennis Knight has over 40 years' experience in the design, construction, operation and maintenance of high performance buildings. He is an ASHRAE Director at Large, an ASHRAE Fellow (FASHRAE) and ASHRAE Distinguished Lecturer. Mr. Knight's expertise lies in Building Information Modeling (BIM) and Integrated Building Design. He currently chairs both the ASHRAE BIM Multi-disciplinary Task Group, where he is the liaison to the International Building Smart Alliance, and the annual ASHRAE Energy Modeling Conference.

Mr. Knight frequently lectures in the US and abroad on high performance building tools and technology and has authored numerous publications and white papers on a variety of technical topics. He has developed curriculum and teaches on BIM, Integrated Building Design, Life Cycle Cost Analysis, ASHRAE 90.1 and IECC energy code compliance, energy management for historic structures in hot and humid climates, and energy modeling and commissioning of energy using systems.

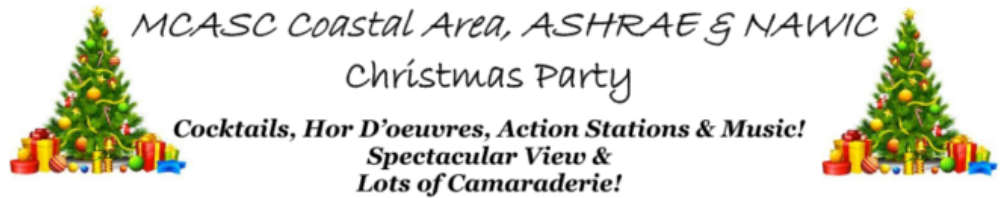
